I am writing to thank you for the interest you shared in your son/daughter's education during City Academy Norwich's Ofsted inspection on 26th and 27th April.

The full report will be sent by Group Call on the afternoon of Tuesday 6th June, the highlights are below.

The report states: *"The principal and her team are passionate about improving all aspects of the school so that pupils receive the best education". "As a result, the current pupils are making better progress across a range of subjects and the school is calmer and more orderly than in the past."*

Alongside this, inspectors also highlighted the following strengths:

1. Teaching, learning and assessment was judged to be most effective in mathematics.
2. English is improving, supported by interventions by the Academy to develop pupils' reading skills.
3. The academy *"promotes pupils' welfare very well"* and pupils feel safe at the school.
4. The Academy's *"decisive approach to improving behaviour"* has had a positive impact.
