

City Academy Norwich Behaviour for learning Protocol

Consequences of Behaviour

This behaviour management system is based on the principle that no student has the right to disrupt the learning of other students and allow the teacher to teach and deal effectively with low level disruption in the classroom.

The Consequence Process

C1 - First misbehaviour – warning

C2 - Second misbehaviour – warning

C3 - Third misbehaviour – final warning

Parents/carers will be informed that three behaviour marks have been issued to their child for a lesson. Please discuss and guide your child to make the right choices in future.

PLEASE NOTE IF STUDENTS STOP THEIR POOR BEHAVIOUR AT THIS POINT THEN NO FURTHER SANCTIONS ARE APPLIED AND THEY START AFRESH IN THE NEXT LESSON

This is now serious and parents/carers should stress to their children that the next stages must be avoided at all costs

C4 - Fourth misbehaviour – student sent to another teaching group for remainder of the lesson **and** will be required to remain for 20 min at the end of the same school day. Parents/carers will be informed through text message.

C5 - Fifth misbehaviour – student sent to Inclusion Room for 3 periods and social time. Parents will be informed through text message. A phone call with Leader of Year will follow.

C6 - Sixth misbehaviour – Principal and Senior Leadership Team involvement
