## RESPECT AROUND THE ACADEMY

City Academy Norwich expects students to be respectful at all times. Students should behave in a way that reflects positively on themselves and the Academy, and demonstrates consideration to others ie.

- Wearing the correct uniform at all times
- Eating or drinking in the appropriate social areas of the Academy
- Using bins for litter and keeping the environment neat and tidy
- Walking in the corridors
- Sitting in the appropriate areas during social time
- Using appropriate language as expected in business or the workplace

## RESPECT FOR YOUR LEARNING

Students should approach learning in every lesson in a positive and enthusiastic manner with a view to always doing their very best:

- ***I will RESPECT myself*** – *enjoy your learning, be the best you can and give things a try.*
- ***I will RESPECT my teachers*** – *listen to what they say, have a positive attitude and follow all instructions.*
- ***I will RESPECT other students***– *support and listen to each other, always stay calm and report any bullying.*
- ***I will RESPECT the classroom*** – *keep it tidy, take care of equipment and use things properly.*

Should your behaviour have an impact on your learning, or that of other students', you may be asked to go to the exit room. It is expected that you should do this quickly and quietly, in order that you don't disturb other students' learning.

If you are sent to the exit room, you will need to attend a restorative conversation with the member of staff who asked you to leave their lesson. This will normally take place on the day of the send out.

# MOBILE PHONES AND SMART DEVICES

Students may bring their mobile phones and Smart devices into the Academy, however, it is then their responsibility to look after them.

Mobile phones and Smart devices must be kept out of sight in bags and not used by students during the Academy day. This includes lesson times, break, lunch, before the start and at the end of the day. If a student has a mobile phone out it could be confiscated, held in a secure place and will need to be collected by the student's parent/carer.

The use of mobile devices to access social network sites\* is not allowed. Should students access these sites during the school day, even during social times, then the Academy may confiscate the device until the end of the day.

*\*ie Facebook, Snapchat, Instagram, MSM, Twitter, BBM, Personal YouTube accounts, Google Accounts, Ask FM and Bebo.*
